The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.398 dated 16.08.2020 registered under Sections 498-A, 306, 34 IPC at Police Station Tosham, District Bhiwani.

Notice of motion was issued on 24.09.2020 on the premise that the complainant has executed an affidavit dated 10.09.2020, thereby clarifying in para No.6 that death of Rekha was not on account of any role played by her husband or her in-laws.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 24.09.2020, the petitioner has joined

the investigation.

This fact has been admitted by Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Rohtash and states that petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of above, order dated 24.09.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when required to do so by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
