In the present criminal writ petition filed under Section 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek directions, to decide the representation dated 21.09.2020 (Annexure P-4) and for protection of their life and liberty from private respondents No.4 to 7, on account of having married on 21.09.2020.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Gurtej Singh Sandhu, PPS, DSP, Sub-Division, Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, has been filed, in pursuance of the order dated 24.09.2020, wherein they had been directed to take appropriate action in accordance with law and also verify the factum of the age of the petitioner No.1.

As per the reply filed, it has been found that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 04.06.2002, as per her school record (Annexure R-1).

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Private respondents No.4 to 7, who are the relatives of petitioner No.1 have also stated that they have no objection to the marriage and will not interfere in the married life of the petitioners. Their statements have also been recorded by the police authorities. The petitioner No.1 is stated to be not available having gone to some unknown place, as per the statement of Makhan Singh, the parental uncle of petitioner No.2.

Keeping in view the above, it is apparent that the present petition has been rendered infructuous, in view of the stand of the private respondents and is disposed off as such.
