Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that after registration of FIR No.233, dated 18.05.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 288, 269, 270, 323, 307, 506 IPC and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh (Annexure P-1), the investigation is not progressing fairly. Petitioner has approached the respondents through various representations, detail whereof has been given in Para 3 of the petition. It is mentioned that the representations/complaints had been submitted by the petitioner on 22.06.2020, 20.07.2020 and 12.08.2020 to various officers. Though the said representations have not been appended but it has been mentioned that another representation dated 04.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) has been submitted by the petitioner to the Director General of Police, Haryana and the Superintendent of Police, Nuh, highlighting

therein his grievance. Request has also been made that the investigation be got conducted fairly and impartially from the senior police officer of the independent agency like State Crime Branch. However, the above referred various representations have not yielded any result.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Superintendent of Police, Nuh, District Nuh-respondent No.4 to consider the representation dated 04.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law within some specified time.

Without going into the merits of the case and commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Nuh, District Nuh-respondent No.4 to look into the representation dated 04.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found therein to take appropriate steps in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
