Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.306 dated 31.8.2020, under Sections 198, 406, 409 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

It is a case of the petitioner that the present allegations against him were totally wrong and in fact the allegations were regarding misappropriation of money, which was made at RBL Finserv Limited and the petitioner was wrongly implicated in the present case and there was no

reason for the same. He has further submitted that in fact the petitioner herself became complainant because she made the complaint to the vigilance bureau regarding fraud which was committed in the branch and that the complaint was made in the month of May, 2020 and on 2nd June, 2020. The raid was conducted by the vigilance bureau on 03.7.2020 but very strangely, the petitioner was named in the FIR. He has further submitted that the petitioner was rather helping by giving information to the vigilance but strangely enough that her name was roped up in the present FIR.

Notice of motion was issued in this case and the learned State counsel was directed to seek instructions in this regard and in the meanwhile, interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Today, Mr. Munish Sharma, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ramniwas has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she has fully cooperated with the investigation process. He has further submitted that the petitioner is not required for custodial investigation in the present case.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 24.09.2020 is hereby made absolute.
