The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioners have preferred this petition for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the service rendered by the petitioner on the post of SPO as qualifying service for the purpose of seniority for the post of Constable and all other consequential benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioners places reliance upon the judgments passed by the High Court in the following cases:-

i. CR No.2295 of 2010 titled 'Constable

Rajinder Kumar vs State of Punjab through Principal Secretary Home, Department of Home Affairs & Justice, Mini Secretariat, Punjab Chandigarh and others'.

ii. CWP No.31922 of 2019 titled 'Avtar Singh vs State of Punjab and others'.

iii. CWP No.14567 of 2020 titled 'Roop Singh and others vs State of Punjab and others'.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case their pending legal notice dated 06.02.2020 issued to the respondents is decided.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Monica Chhibber Sharma, Sr. D.A.G, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass, there is no necessity of calling upon any response from the respondents, as no order prejudicial to the interest of any party is being passed.

This writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the pending legal notice dated 06.02.2020 of the petitioners in accordance with law by way of

passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
