2. Mr. Harbir Sandhu, Asstt. Advocate General, Punjab to accept notice on behalf of the Respondent/State. A copy of the Paper-book be supplied to him.

3. Perused the impugned order passed by the Ld. Judge, Special Court, Kapurthala on 29th April, 2017 vide which the Petitioner was declared a Proclaimed Person.

4. Petitioner's explanation in this regard is that there was a miscommunication from his Counsel which led him to believe that his matter had been admitted and he need not to appear in the Ld. Trial Court after having been granted Regular Bail.

5. Without making any comments on the merits of the Petitioner's explanation in this regard, at this stage, the matter is disposed off with a liberty to the Petitioner to surrender before the Ld.
