Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.87 dated 25.6.2020, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 427, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 25, 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present FIR he has been wrongly roped in and falsely implicated and even otherwise it was a case of cross version and the role attributable as per the FIR, to the petitioner was that he has fired a shot from the revolver, however, there was no injury caused to anybody from any fire-arm. Learned counsel further argued that rather the complainant had inflicted

serious injuries to Kabul Singh, who is the uncle of petitioner and further referred to the DDR, which was lodged against the other party vide Annexure P-2.

Notice of motion was issued in the present case and the petitioner was granted interim protection on 24.9.2020 subject to the compliance of conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Today learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he has fully cooperated with the investigation process and is not further required for any custodial interrogation.

In view of the stand taken by the State, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 24.9.2020 is hereby made absolute.
