Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Shri Davinder Singh, Senior Assistant, O/o Education Recruitment Directorate, Mohali, informs the Court that despite considering the claim of the petitioner, as per the order dated 13.07.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner would not come within the zone of selected candidates or even in the waiting list. The cut off marks of the general candidates is 67.0479 and of the Backward Class category candidates is 65.0702.

Since the petitioner, according to the consideration of the claim of the petitioner, irrespective of his entitlement, does not fall in the said zone, the claim, as made by the petitioner, even if accepted, would not confer a right of appointment on him.

In view of the above, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
