Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity to serve the private respondents or to seek a reply from any one of the respondents.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to objectively considered representation dated 02.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) and to pass a speaking order thereupon, within 08 weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
