The petitioner is an Ex-Sarpanch of village Baje-ke, District Ferozepur.

It has been stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner remained Sarpanch for four terms. The following four FIRs have been got registered at the instance of the petitioner or his brother:-

(1)FIR No.147 dated 12.10.2017 under Sections 452/323/148/149 IPC, Police Station Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur.

(2)FIR No.0089 dated 13.06.2018 under Sections 307/452/379-B/427/506/148/149/120-B IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, Police Station Guruhar Sahai, District Ferozepur.

(3)FIR No.0010 dated 18.01.2019 under Sections 452/323/148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Guru harsahai, District Ferozepur.

(4)FIR No.93 dated 01.06.2020 under Sections 307/450/427/188/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur.

The petitioner is apprehending threat and danger to his life and liberty. He has already submitted a representation dated 10.07.2020 (Annexure P-10) to respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Anu Pal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. She, on instructions from SI Balraj Singh, contends that security consisting of two police officials has already been provided to the petitioner and further in the event the threat perception continuous or the circumstances of the case required more security to the petitioner, the appropriate action will be initiated and the decision will be taken on the aforesaid representation dated 10.07.2020 (Annexure P-10), in accordance with law.

Without making any comment on the genuineness of the allegations, as put forth in the aforesaid representation, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as projected in aforesaid representation, in accordance with law.
