The petitioner prays for grant of transit anticipatory bail for a period of 30 days in FIR No.68 dated 26.08.2020 registered under Section 498-A, 377, 406, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Nahan, Himachal Pradesh.

The petitioners are residents of Gurugram and the FIR in question has been registered at Nahan, District Sirmour, Himachal Pradesh. The first informant is the daughter-in-law of the petitioners. She alongwith her husband was settled in Dubai. The allegations in the FIR are arising from marital discord. It is also alleged that her husband had committed unnatural intercourse with her 3-4 occasions against her wishes.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, it is considered appropriate to grant transit pre arrest bail to the petitioners for 15 days enabling the petitioners to move an application before the Court of competent jurisdiction.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of, in view of the aforesaid order.
