This is a petition that has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to accept the balance Custom Milled Rice “CMR” as per balance allotted CMR stock as the respondents have refused to accept the same being delayed.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that the Government of India, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Department of Food and Public Distribution has issued letter dated 24.09.2020, which has been addressed to the Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Govt of Haryana whereby the time prayed for delivery of CMR has been extended till 15.10.2020 and in view of said letter wherein the time prayed

for delivery of milled paddy and CMR has already been extended, he does not press the instant writ petition and seeks permission to withdraw the same with liberty to approach the Court again in case the grievance survives.

Mr. S. S. Pannu, DAG, Haryana appears on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and Mr. Naveen Chopra, Advocate appearing on behalf of FCI, Haryana Division, do not dispute the factual position regarding the above said letter.

Petition stands dismissed being not pressed, with liberty as aforesaid.
