The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66 dated 02.06.2016, under Sections 498-A, 420 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner herein prays for grant of regular bail to the petitioner on the ground that the matter between the parties has been compromised and in terms of the compromise arrived at, a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act has already been filed and an amount of ₹ 3,00,000/- has already been paid towards the payment payment.

Per contra, learned State counsel as well as counsel appearing

on behalf of respondent No.2-complainant, on instructions of Mandeep Kaur-complainant, who is present in person endorses the statement made by counsel for the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the matter stands compromised between the parties, pursuant to which a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act has already been filed and part payment of ₹ 3,00,000/- has already been made to the complainant, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and the order dated 04.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
