This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 14.09.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/2, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Harbir Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. Complete copy of paperbook has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to consider representation dated 14.09.2020 (Annexure P/2) and issue necessary orders, as warranted by law, so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.
