The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This is 3rd petition for grant of bail to the petitioner pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.47, dated 08.03.2019, registered under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner along with a co-accused was apprehended with 5.500 kg. Charas. The co-accused of the petitioner after throwing the narcotics tried to escape but apprehended. The petitioner was owner and driver of the car in which they were apprehended. He was apprehended at the spot.

Ms. Samina Dhir, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab has informed the court that the petitioner is not a person with clean antecedents as there is another case pending against him under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

The second bail application of the petitioner was dismissed on 20.11.2019. No fresh ground for grant of bail is made out.
