1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, is for taking action against the respondent for not complying with judgment (Annexure P-1) dated 17.07.2020, passed in CWP No.9993 of 2020 in case titled as 'Arjun Nath versus Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula'.
3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 17.07.2020, CWP No.9993 of 2020 was disposed of by directing the respondent to pass a speaking order upon representation dated 16.06.2020 within 06 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order but till date, no decision has been taken in respect thereto.
4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. Sanjay Mittal, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is present, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and states that in case some more

time is granted, needful would be done and the order of this Court dated 17.07.2020 passed in CWP No.9993 of 2020 would be complied with.

6. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, in the light of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any orders except for directing the respondent to consider and decide the representation dated 16.06.2020 within a period of 03 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and to convey the decision taken on the same to the petitioner within the aforementioned period of time.

8. However, it is made clear that in case the needful is not done within the stipulated period of time, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
