The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner has preferred this petition for issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to register a criminal case against the private respondents under Sections 323/ 324/ 325/ 326/ 148/149 IPC at Police Station Tibber, Tehsil and District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner brings to the notice of this Court that the petitioner and his son were given injuries by the private respondents. They were hospitalized on 22.1.2020 and injuries were noticed by the doctor in the medico

legal reports. Medical ruqa was sent. Police came to the hospital and recorded the statements of the injured, but no FIR has been registered till date despite a representation dated 27.1.2020 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur-respondent No.3 and SHO, Police Station, Tibber -respondent No.4. Petitioner has also moved a representation dated 4.2.2020 (Annexure P-5) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur-respondent No.3, representation dated 24.7.2020 (Annexure P-6) to Director General of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No.2 and a complaint dated 13.8.2020 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.4. Till date, no action has been taken by any of the concerned quarter.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr.Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any response at this stage, as no order prejudicial to the interest of respondents is being passed.

In view of above, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, respondent No.3 is directed to decide the representation dated 27.1.2020 (Annexure P-4) filed by the

petitioner in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
