1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Prayer in the Petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is for punishing the respondent for willfully and intentionally disobeying the order of this Court Annexure P/3 dated 18.12.2019, passed in CRM-M-2463-2015 and order Annexure P/2 dated 03.12.2018, in CRM-M-53194-2018, directing the respondents to complete the investigation of case FIR No.255 dated 29.10.2014, U/s 420 IPC and Sections 63/69, Copyright Act, 1957, registered at Police Station Amritsar City, District Amritsar, within stipulated period of time.
3. Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only.
4. Ms. Deepali Puri, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and on instructions from respondent No.1 states that investigation was concluded by the State and Cyber Crime, SAS Nagar on 15.09.2020, decision has been taken to recommend cancellation of the FIR and that report in respect thereto would be submitted to the concerned Commissioner of Police on 12.10.2010, whereafter action in accordance with law would be taken by the concerned Commissioner of Police.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the statement of learned Addl. AG, Punjab, he does not press the contempt petition and same may be disposed of by directing respondent No. 1 to submit report to the concerned Commissioner of Police, on 12.10.2020 for appropriate action in accordance with law.

6. Accordingly, in the light of the position as noted above, the Contempt Petition is disposed of as not calling for any orders except directing respondent No.1 to submit report to the concerned Commissioner of Police on 12.10.2020 for appropriate action in accordance with law.
