The case has been taken up by way of Video Conference as per instructions in view of COVID-19 pandemic.

The grievance of petitioners is that respondents No. 5 to 7 forcibly trespassed into their house. They have threatened them. They have also caused injuries to petitioners No. 3 and 4. Private respondents were threatening petitioner No. 1 to produce his son Chandan Bansal, who they alleged, has eloped with daughter of respondent No. 5 namely Ramesh whereas petitioner No. 1 does not know about whereabouts of his son. Infact, petitioner has disinherited his son Chandan Bansal by issuing a public notice. Petitioners apprehend danger to their lives at the hands of private respondents. In regard to his grievance, petitioner No. 1 has already made representation dated 20.9.2020 addressed amongst others to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana City (respondent No. 3) but no decision thereon has been taken so far.

Without commenting anything on the merits of case and opining on the veracity of allegations contained in representation, this petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana City (respondent No. 3) to look into representation and take such action as may be warranted in law.
