Counsel for the petitioner would state that in compliance with order dated 28.09.2020, the petitioner joined investigation and is ready to cooperate throughout.

Counsel representing the State would concede to the factum of joining of investigation but would oppose the prayer for bail with the submissions that articles of *istri dhan* of the complainant are yet to be recovered.

Counsel for the complainant would submit that allegations have been levelled against the petitioner with regard to committing cruelty.

Perusal of the FIR would reveal that there are vague allegations against the petitioner with regard to giving beatings and extending threats. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner with regard to entrustment of particular articles of dowry. The petitioner has already joined investigation and is ready to comply with the terms and conditions, if any, imposed by the Court.

In view of the above, petition is allowed. Interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 28.09.2020 is made absolute subject to conditions stipulated in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
