[1]. Affidavit of the Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, in compliance of the order dated 29.10.2020 has been filed.

[2]. In Para No.4 of the same, it has been mentioned that on perusing the Legal Opinion sent by the DDA (Legal) of the concerned District, the complaint on behalf of respondent No.5 has been filed, by the respondent No.3.

[3]. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of this development, he is not inclined to pursue the present petition any further and wants the same to be withdrawn.

[4]. Ld. Counsel for respondent No.5, from his side, submits that while he cannot oppose withdrawal of the petition, such permission in no way should be construed to mean that this Court has necessarily accepted

the decision of respondent No.3 to file the complaint on merits as correct, and to meet this end, respondent No.5 would be at liberty to seek appropriate legal remedies, in case he is aggrieved by filing of the concerned complaint.

[5]. In view of the above submission, the present petition is dismissed as having been withdrawn and in case respondent No.5 has any grievance left, it will be at liberty to seek an appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
