1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for knowingly and willfully disobeying order Annexure P/1 dated 16.09.2016 in CWP No.16575 of 2016.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents contends that in view of order Annexure R-2/1 dated 08.10.2020, no further orders are called for and the contempt petition may be disposed of as such.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in the circumstances, she does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 08.10.2020 passed by respondent No.2 in accordance with law.
5. The same is not opposed to learned counsel for the respondents.

6. Accordingly, in view of the position as noted above, the contempt

petition is disposed of as not pressed while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 08.10.2020 in accordance with law.
