The first bail petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed on 11.08.2020. The order dated 11.08.2020, passed in CRM-M-24750-2019 is extracted as under:-

“It is not disputed that the trial of the case has already made substantial progress as 16 prosecution witnesses have already been examined.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court does not find it appropriate to consider the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner, at this stage.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.”

No fresh ground for grant of bail to the petitioner is made out.
