The hearing of the case was held through video conference, on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Although, learned counsel representing the petitioners has not come forward to attend the hearing of the case, however, learned counsel for the State of Haryana, has submitted that the correct result of the petitioners, for NCVT examination July-August 2019, has already been uploaded.

On 24.11.2020, the following order was passed:-

Mr. Samarth Sagar, Addl. A.G. Haryana, has stated that it is the Union of India, which has to upload the result of the students and all the formalities from side of the State of Haryana have been completed.

Mr. Harneet Singh Oberoi, Advocate for the Union of India, has stated that the Union of India is not in a position to upload the result unless the State of Haryana provides the details of the students alongwith their father's name and their roll numbers.

It has been noticed that the petitioners, who are studying in the Industrial Training Institute, are being made to run from pillar to post for quite sometime.

In these circumstances, last opportunity is granted to the State of Haryana as well as the Union of India, to sort out their differences, failing which this

Court shall be compelled to direct the Secretary of Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, of Union of India as well as the State of Haryana, to come personally present in the Court, to explain how they are playing with the future of the students. List on 01.12.2020.”

An affidavit of Mr. Sanjiv Sharma, Joint Director (Technical), Department of Skill Development and Industrial Training, Haryana, has been forwarded on the official e-mail of the Court, stating as under:-

3.That the respondent department through the present affidavit wishes to clarify that exams for trades affiliated with National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) are conducted by Director General of Training (DGT), Govt. of India, New Delhi, results are also declared by Director General of Training (DGT), Govt. of India, New Delhi on their NCVTMIS portal. Certificate also awarded by Director General of Training (DGT)/ National council for vocational Training (NCVT) to successful trainees.

4. That it is further submitted that the petitioners appeared for exam in July 2019, subsequently, results were declared in December, 2019 for semester system and in January, 2020 for Annual system. At that point of time, it was found that result for some of the trainees was not updated on portal for which repeated requests dated 06.12.2019, 28.7.2020 and 21.10.2020 (alongwith details of trainees) were made to Director General of Training (DGT), Govt. of India, New Delhi. In this regard, D.O. letter dated 09.06.2020 and 28.10.2020 (along with details of trainees) was also written with the request to update the result. After that request was made by e-mail on dated 18.11.2020 to which Director General of Training (DGT), Govt. of India, New Delhi replied vide e-mail dated 18.11.2020 stating that this issue will likely to be resolved within few days. Once Director General of Training (DGT), Govt. of India, New Delhi will be ready, State Directorate will be intimated for the same to upload data.

5.That it is pertinent to mention here that on dated 20.11.2020, telephonic message received from Director General of Training (DGT), Govt. of India, New Delhi to send the soft copy of the templates, accordingly same was sent by e-mail dated 20.11.2020 and Director General of Training (DGT), Govt. of India, New Delhi updated the result of Annual System, Semester-IV and Semester-II on dated 23.11.2020 which was checked by

the respondent department on NCVTMIS portal and found that result of petitioners belonging to semester-Ill is yet to be updated, accordingly, request by e-mail dated 24.11.2020 was made to Director General of Training (DGT), Govt. of India, New Delhi for updation of result of Semester-Ill.

6. That it is submitted that the result of all the petitioners of semester-Ill has been updated by Director General of Training (DGT), Govt of India, New Delhi on dated 25.11.2020. All the petitioners except petitioner no. 24 (roll no. 170806039644) and petitioner no. 36 (roll no. 170806039647 of semester-Ill) are passed in Practical and Engineering Drawing subject. Petitioners bearing roll number 170806039644, 170806039647 of semester-III are actually failed in practical subject. copy of the award roll of petitioner no. 24 and 36 are annexed as Annexure R-1(colly.) and the copy of the updated result of the remaining petitioners is annexed as Annexure R-2.”

Keeping in view the aforesaid affidavit, the writ petition is disposed of, having been rendered infructuous.

However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to move an application for revival, if the grievance subsists.
