The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for quashing of impugned action of the respondents in making recovery/adjustment of amounts at the rate of 12.50/- pere quintal on account of transportation charges of paddy shifted against the release orders for crop year 2017-2018 with a further prayer that the impugned recovery be also stayed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that notice was served upon the respondents vide Annexure P-6 and also relied upon Annexures P-7 to P-9 which are orders passed by co-ordinate Bench of this Court and categorically submitted that the present case is identical with the aforesaid Annexures P-7 to P-9. He has further submitted that the present petition can be disposed of in terms of Annexure P-8.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Suveer Sheokand, Addl. A.G., Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Advocate has caused appearance on behalf of respondent No.3 and Mr. Dhwij Dutt, Advocate has caused appearance on behalf of respondents No.4, 6, 8, 9 and 11.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties through video conferencing.

All the aforesaid counsel for respondents have stated that they have no objection in case appropriate directions be issued for deciding the representation in terms of Annexure P-8, in which, according to them, identical issue was involved.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.11932 of 2020, decided on 17.8.2020, titled 'Radhe Krishna Rice Mills and others vs. State of Punjab', annexed with this petition as Annexure P-8.
