MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA J. (ORAL)

In pursuance of the order dated 24.09.2020, the Warrant Officer has submitted his report dated 01.10.2020 in a sealed cover. The same has been ordered to be open and is taken on record.

A perusal of the said report shows that the alleged detainee was not found in illegal custody and rather she was found present at the Police Station, Sector-19, Chandigarh for the purpose of getting her statement recorded in respect of GD No.067 dated 16.09.2020 and she scribed her statement to the effect that she had left the house of the petitioner out of her own free-will and was staying with her friend at Bharatpur, Rajasthan, voluntarily, without any fear or pressure and she is not willing to go with the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the above-said facts and rather states that in these circumstances, the present petition has become infructuous and may be dismissed, accordingly.

Resultantly, this petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
