This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C has been filed for directing respondent no.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in criminal case arising from DDR No. 23, dated 14.11.2019, under Section 307, 452, 336, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered as cross case in FIR No.162 dated 1.9.2019 registered under Section 307, 323, 324,341, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

Pursuant to the notice, Ms. Samina Dhir, DAG, Punjab has appeared and submitted that in the present case inquiry is being conducted by the Superintendent of Police, Headquarter Amritsar.

From the reading of the petition, it is apparent that there are no allegations of any kind against the Superintendent of Police, Headquarter Amritsar.

Keeping in view the fact that the FIR was registered on 1.9.2019 whereas DDR was registered on 14.11.2019, it is considered appropriate to direct Superintendent of Police, Headquarter to complete the inquiry within one month from the date of receipt of the copy of the order. The petitioner, if still aggrieved, would be at liberty to take steps in accordance with law.
