Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of Pandemic COVID-19.

Through this petition under Section 226 of the Constitution of India prayer has been made for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide adequate security and protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 and further issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action against respondents No.4 to 7 on the basis of complaint filed by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the purpose would be achieved if Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-7) dated nil (postal receipt dated 21.09.2020) moved by the petitioners, in a time-bound manner.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, but without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of

Police, Mohali, to look into the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-7) and decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
