The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR N.141 dated 12.09.2020 under Sections 379 IPC and Section 21(1) of the Mine & Minerals (Regulators & Development) Act, 1957 at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

The operative part of the order dated 06.10.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the vernacular of the affidavit of the petitioner, to submit that though he is not the registered owner of the tractor bearing registration No.PB-04-S-9619 but is in possession of the same by virtue of an affidavit.
