The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner has preferred this petition only qua protection of her life and personal liberty.

Petitioner has alleged that she is a lady of 76 years of age. Owing to the family circumstances arising out of relations between her son and daughter-in-law/ respondent No.7, her husband has died. Reconciliation between her son and respondent No.7 has not yielded any result. Even a divorce petition was got dismissed as withdrawn. Son of the petitioner and respondent No.7 never resided in Amritsar. Respondent Nos. 5 to 7 are pressuring the petitioner to transfer her house in

the name of respondent No.7 and have also demanded money. Even the petitioner was manhandled.

Precisely, for the grievance in question, petitioner has already approached respondents No.2 and 3 by way of representation dated 31.8.2020 (Annexure P-2) but the same has not yielded any result.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any response at this stage, as no order prejudicial to the interest of respondents is being passed.

In view of above, without meaning anything on the merits of the case, respondent No.3 is directed to decide the representation dated 31.8.2020 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
