ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Vide this petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., the petitioner prays for a direction to the official respondents to register an FIR against respondent No.4 i.e. Jagir Singh, who happens to be her husband, for the offenses, as detailed in the petition, he has allegedly committed. And, for, the petitioner apprehends danger to her life and liberty, she be also provided the necessary protection.

Notice of motion, confined to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Mr.A.A.Pathak, Addl.A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents and submits, for, the petitioner has already submitted a complaint/representation dated 01.09.2020 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda (respondent No.2), which is pending

consideration, let this petition be disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondents-authorities to consider and deal with her concerns/grievances within a specified time and pass appropriate orders.

In the wake of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to consider and deal with the concerns/grievances raised by the petitioner, set out in her complaint/representation dated 01.09.2020 (Annexure P-1), pending consideration before respondent No.2, expeditiously, preferably, within four weeks, from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Needless to assert that this order shall not constitute any expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
