The petitioner-Hardayal Singh has filed the present writ petition with the prayer to set aside the order dated 28.04.2008 (Annexure P-11), whereby the petitioner was dismissed from service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the writ petition was filed in the year 2012. Thereafter, during pendency of the writ petition, the petitioner has been acquitted in the criminal case in the year 2016.

Reply dated 14.02.2013 was filed by Shri Rajpal Singh Sandhu, PPS, Commandant 7th Battalion, PAP, Jalandhar Cantt, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6. Affidavit dated 27.02.2020, has been filed by Harkamalpreet Singh Khakh, PPS, Commandant, 7th Battalion, PAP, Jalandhar Cantt, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6. In the said affidavit, it has been submitted that the appeal filed by the petitioner has been accepted

by the Government. Vide order dated 21.11.2019, petitioner has been taken back in service and he has been allotted the new Regtl. number also.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are called for.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage submits that since consequential benefits have not been granted, he be given liberty to file a fresh writ petition praying for aforementioned relief.

Writ petition is disposed of accordingly, with liberty as prayed for.
