The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 66 dated 07.04.2020, under Sections 148, 323, 324, 307, 325, 452, 506, 188 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury is attributed to the petitioner and he is alleged to have caught hold of the complainant's father. He also contends that there is a delay of two days in lodging the FIR.

This Court, by the order dated 29.09.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Roop Singh, contends that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner having joined investigation and the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 29.09.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
