The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.68 dated 14.05.2020 registered under Sections 61/1/14 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner alongwith Raj Kumar, co-accused are in the habit of smuggling liquor from Chandigarh to Punjab.

Learned Additional Sessions Judge, while dismissing the application, has noticed that the petitioner is also an accused in FIR No.38 dated 08.03.2020 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

Learned counsel for the State has pointed out that another accused in the present case is the petitioner's son.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, there is no ground to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
