The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 19.2.2020, vide which, direction was issued to ensure compliance of the order dated 22.11.2019. As per the order dated 22.11.2019, the respondents were supposed to take final decision.

It is evident and not disputed that the said final decision was with respect to the pending departmental proceedings i.e. whether the charge-sheet which was proposed to be dropped or the enquiry contemplated.

Reply dated 7.12.2020 has been filed. As per the said reply, the departmental proceedings stand concluded and the petitioner has since been reinstated. Thus, this fact is evident from para Nos.10 to 12 of the reply.

Under these circumstances, this Court finds that the respondent has complied with the order in letter and spirit except the copy of the order has neither been attached with the reply nor handed over to the petitioner.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is rendered infructuous. Dismissed accordingly.

The said order passed by the authority with respect to the departmental proceedings be supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner/petitioner during the course of the day.
