This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent No.4. It is further prayed that possession of the petitioners on the land mentioned in Annexure P-1, be also protected.

A bare perusal of the paper book shows that the present case involves only the civil dispute between the respective parties. Therefore, the petitioners have the remedy of filing civil suit for getting appropriate relief from the civil Court, if otherwise entitled to. Therefore, this Court finds that the present petition has been filed with an oblique motive to create some kind of document to create pressure on the other side. This Court does not find any substance in this petition.

Besides this, there is nothing on record to even remotely suggests

any threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners, except the bald assertions made by the petitioners.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to interfere in the matter.

Dismissed.
