The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on
account of restrictions due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

This order shall dispose of five criminal miscellaneous petitions
i.e. (i) CRM-M-30534-2020 (M/s Jindal Trading Company vs. State of
Haryana and ors.); (ii) CRM-M-26640-2020 (M/s Sumer Trading
Company vs. State of Haryana and ors.); (iii) CRM-M-26642-2020 (M/s
Rajinder Kumar Ramesh Chand vs. State of Haryana and ors.); (iv)
CRM-M-40456-2018 (M/s Sumer Chand & Brothers vs. State of Haryana
and ors.); (v) CRM-M-40398-2018 (M/s Shiv Enterprises vs. State of

Haryana and ors.); these petitions have been filed *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to file the status report or to arrest the respondents No. 4 to 6, who have already been declared Proclaimed person by the JMIC, Kurukshetra vide order dated 28.10.2017 and 28.10.2017 (Annexure P-1 & P-2) in a complaint case No.NACT-440 of 2016 filed on dated 31.05.2016 & Complaint No. NACT-441 of 2016 filed on 31.05.2016 u/s 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act and information has already been sent to the office of SP Kurukshetra and application for registering the FIR & for arrest the respondent No.6 has already given by the petitioner on dated 11.08.2017 (Annexure P-3). CRM-M-30534-2020 is being treated as the lead case for the purposes of order.

Records of the case show that on 30.09.2020, notice of motion was issued and the State was directed to file the reply.

Learned State counsel submits that the reply is ready and it has been shared on the Whatsapp Group. He further submits that he will direct his office to place the reply on record within two days.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that in the meantime, respondent No.6 has been arrested and further investigation is still going on.

Without commenting on the merits of case, the petitioner(s) is permitted to appear and file a representation before the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra-respondent No.2. Respondent No.2 is directed to examine the representation and also dispose of the same within a period of **three months** from today.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
