Case taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.34 dated 15.06.2020 registered under Sections 452, 323 and 148 IPC at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case; there is unexplained delay of 08 days in lodging of the FIR; the alleged injuries are simple in nature; the matter between the parties has been compromised and therefore the chances of the petitioner's conviction are extremely bleak and that under the interim orders passed by this Court the petitioner has not only joined the investigation he has also fully cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder

Singh submits that under the interim orders passed by this Court the petitioner has not only joined the investigation he has also fully co-operated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

Keeping in view the totality of the above noticed facts especially the statement made by the learned State counsel that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the order of this Court dated 29.09.2020, granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

Nothing observed herein-above shall be considered to be an expression of opinion by this Court on the merits of the case.
