JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 not to harass the petitioner and her family members in FIR No. 145 dated 06.09.2020 under Sections 489-A, 489-B, 489-C IPC registered at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot by conducting unnecessary raids in the house of the petitioner and threatening her and her family members. At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that representation dated 17.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) should be decided expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been wrongly implicated in the said FIR which is registered at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot on the basis of a secret information against the husband of the petitioner. It is contended that in case the police authorities want to investigate the said matter, they may do so in accordance

with law while associating with the authorities at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur where the petitioner along with her relatives is residing. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the respondents.

Ms. Rashmi Attari, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and that the investigation will be done in accordance with law and that in case the authorities at Police Station Jaito, District Faridkot requires to carry on any investigation against the petitioner, they will do so after associating with the local police station at Ferozepur. Let a complete copy of the paper book be served upon the State counsel during course of the day on Whatsapp number or through e-mail.

The instant petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to conduct a fair and impartial investigation in the above-said FIR and to decide the representation dated 17.09.2020 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
