This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 112 dated 13.3.2019 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Shahabad District Kurukshetra.

On 4.7.2019, while issuing notice of motion, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the only allegation in the case is that one Pardeep Kumar was carrying on business of illicit liquor by transporting the same in a truck owned and

driven by him only. On the said date, a consignment, which was shown to be loaded from Rajpura, as per the papers recovered by the Police; and which was alleged to be meant to be transported to Andhra Pradesh, was found in the truck. However, neither the petitioners are connected with the above said Pardeep Kumar nor they are connected with the consigner or consignee. They have no business connection with either of the above said parties.

Notice of motion for 16.10.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prem Chand, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required in any further investigation of the case.

In view of above interim order dated 4.7.2019 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall abide by the

conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
