SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition for regular bail filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.114 dated 22.07.2020, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station City Jalalabad, District Fazilka.

[2]. According to the Ld. Counsel for the petitioner, his client was arrested in this case almost two months ago on 10.08.2020, and has remained in detention thereafter.

[3]. It is the further case of the petitioner that she is neither a party nor a Signatory to the alleged Sale Agreement between the complainant and her husband Gurbaz Singh, but has merely roped in to create undue pressure upon her husband for oblique reasons.

[4]. It transpires that co-accused Nirmal Singh had been granted anticipatory bail by this Court earlier in CRM-M-26548-2020, after notice

was taken of the fact that like the present petitioner, the said Nirmal Singh was neither a party nor a Signatory to the disputed Agreement between the Complainant and Gurbaz Singh.

[5]. In these circumstances, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner and the fact that the trial is likely to take its own considerable time due to ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic, as such, the prayer of the petitioner for her release on regular bail is allowed and she is ordered to be released subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
