The prayer in the present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.195 dated 30.10.2019 under Sections 147/148/323/324/379/427 of IPC (lateron added 307 IPC) and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Pillu Khera, District Jind (Haryana).

This is the fourth bail application. The first two bail applications were dismissed as withdrawn on 05.02.2020 abd 29.05.2020 respectively and the third bail application was dismissed because the dismissal of earlier two bail applications had not been mentioned. The last bail application was dismissed on 27.07.2020. The present bail application has been filed on the ground that the matter has been compromised between the parties and quashing petition has been filed in which notice of motion has also been issued.

Learned State counsel however while opposing the bail to the petitioner submitted that it was a well settled proposition of law that the criminal proceedings for offence under Section 307 IPC cannot be quashed. However, this Court is dealing with the bail application. The petitioner is stated to be working at the same Mandi in which the complainant-Parveen @ Monu is working and the matter was settled between the parties in order to maintain amicable atmosphere in the said Mandi.

Be that as it may, learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 & 3 and respondent No.2/complainant-Parveen @ Monu is present in the Court and states that he has no objection, if the petitioner is released on bail and even otherwise, he is in custody since 03.12.2019. Whereas, the charge has also not been framed till date.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing of bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
