In the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 09.06.2011 (Annexure P-5), whereby only the benefit of simple rate of interest was to be calculated on the arrears, as per order of the Assistant Registrar Cooperative Societies, Haryana and the liability to pay was upheld.

The revision filed by the petitioner was dismissed and the order dated 09.06.2011 was upheld on 15.04.2015 (Annexure P-7). During the pendency of the writ petition, it transpired that the petitioner availed the benefit of OTS Scheme and he has paid a sum of Rs.10,44,632/-. Resultantly, civil miscellaneous application bearing CM-12114-CWP-2016 for permission to sell the bus has been moved, which had been purchased from the loan proceeds.

Mr. Gupta, appearing for respondent No.4-Bank has confirmed the said factum.

Accordingly, keeping in view the above the present writ petition is disposed off, in view of the stand of the respondent No.4 and the orders are, accordingly, modified, in view of the matter having been compromised between the parties. Resultantly, CM-12114-CWP-2016 is also disposed off in the same terms.
