Prayer in this petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents to reimburse the medical bills submitted by the husband of petitioner No. 1 and father of petitioner Nos. 2 and 3, namely Late Kamikar Singh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 28.08.2020 (Annexure P-4) to the respondents for redressal of his grievances, however, no action has been taken on the same so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would feel satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No. 3-the Joint Commissioner, Zone-D, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to decide the aforesaid legal notice (Annexure P-4) within a stipulated time.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-the Joint Commissioner, Zone-D,

Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana to decide the aforesaid legal notice/representation (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law after affording an opportunity of hearing to petitioners, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case the petitioners are found entitled to any amount as claimed, the same shall be disbursed to them within a period of one month thereafter.
