Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No. 4.

At this stage, Mr. Vicky Sharma, Advocate, appears for petitioner No. 2-Simranjeet Kaur and files his power of attorney and affidavit dated 15.10.2020 executed by petitioner No. 2, which are taken on record. In the affidavit, petitioner No. 2 has stated that she has not solemnised marriage with petitioner No. 1. Now she is residing with her parents. He points out that respondent No. 4 is the father of petitioner No. 1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner No. 2 wants to withdraw the petition qua her.

Ordered accordingly.

I have also heard the learned counsel for petitioner No. 1 and learned State counsel.

Since petitioner No. 2 has resiled from her earlier affidavit dated 25.09.2020 filed with the petition, no case for allowing the present petition is made out and the same has become infructuous.
