The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed this civil writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus so as to direct the respondents to grant minimum of the regular pay scale to the petitioner for his post of Data Entry Operator-cum-Clerk or in the alternative to grant the pay of prescribed D.C. rate for district Faridabad i.e. Rs.21,780/- instead of actually being paid to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 23.08.2020 (Annexure P-7) to the respondents and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent

No.2 i.e. Director General, Higher Education Department, Haryana to consider the said legal notice in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Sanjay Mittal, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Heard.

Without making any observation on the claim so projected by the petitioner in the present petition, but considering the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 23.08.2020 (Annexure P-7) within six months from today.
