It has been stated that both the petitioner have attained the age of valid marriage under Mohammdan Law and solemnized their marriage on 18.09.2020. The petitioners are apprehending threat and danger to their lives and liberty at the instance of respondent Nos. 4 to 7, who are the relatives of petitioner No.2.

Notice of motion to official respondents only.

Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents.

Without dilating further, suffice is to say that the Court is primarily concerned with the petitioners' right to protect their lives and liberty against any perceived threat at the instance of third party as such right has been guaranteed to them as per Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

It has been pointed out that a representation dated 19.09.2020

(Annexure P-3) has already been submitted to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur, Punjab.

Without making any further observations on the merits or legality and validity of the relationship, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioners as projected through a representation dated 19.09.2020 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law and furthermore, take remedial action if the apprehension of danger is real and genuine one.

This order is not to be construed as any opinion with regard to the legality and validity of relationship of the petitioners as well as their age or with regard to any civil or criminal proceedings.
