With the consent of learned counsel for the parties, the matter is being taken up and heard via video conferencing.

This petition has been filed by the petitioner being aggrieved by an order dated 18.09.2020 by which the petitioner has been debarred for a period of six months and its enlistment certificate for road works has been treated to be cancelled.

Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent-State of Punjab submits that if the petitioner approaches the competent authority by filing a representation, the concerned authority will consider and take a decision thereon expeditiously in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab, the petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner approaches the respondents by way of a representation alongwith a copy of the petition and the order passed

today within two days, the respondent-authority shall consider and decide the same expeditiously and in accordance with law.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and, therefore, respondents would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.
