The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 29.11.2019, vide which, direction was issued to consider and decide the legal notice dated 2.8.2019.

Prayer of the petitioner is two fold. Firstly, for grant of 2<sup>nd</sup> ACP and secondly for VRS.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Naveen, Assistant Director, PGT-IV states that 2<sup>nd</sup> ACP has already been granted but the decision with respect to VRS could not be taken as the deputation period of the petitioner is not mentioned in his service book, for which they have already written to the District Education Officer. As soon as the same is entered in his service book, the decision with respect to the VRS too shall be taken. It is further stated that the needful shall be positively done within four weeks.

The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of in view of the statement made by learned State counsel.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

In case, the needful is not done within the period mentioned above, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
