Present petition has been filed for seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner is a lady, working as Principal of the school and there is dispute with regard to the affairs of the working of the school. However, private respondents alongwith two police officials have tried to hamper the peaceful adtmosphere of the school and it has been stated in para No. 5 of the petition that even they have abused the petitioner with filthy language which had destroyed the dignity of petitioner among the students. He has further submitted that petitioner being lady has become helpless in these circumstances and therefore, she was constrained to file the present petition. He has further submitted that even representation was moved to the Senior

Superintendent of Police, Sangrur(Annexure P-1) dated 18.09.2020 but no action has been taken by the Police.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 at this stage.

Mr. Rupinder Singh Thind, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the aforesaid respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner will be satisfied in case the representation(Annexure P-1) given by the petitioner is decided by the concerned police officials. Learned State counsel states that State has no objection if such direction is issued.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, this Court deems it fit and appropriate to direct respondent No.2 to look into the representation(Annexure P-1) and decide the same within a period of two weeks from today. However, nothing stated hereinabove, shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
